### **EL DORADO**

In the month of September, due to the state-wide wildfire emergency, MVFD once again answered the call to assist with resources to aid the state in battling the many wildfires throughout the state.

WT461 was deployed as Immediate Need to the El Dorado fire burning in the San Bernardino Mountains near Yucaipa where they were assigned to many different roles ranging from supplementing direct attack operations to assisting with structure protection in Forest Falls and Angelus Oaks. The crew on WT461 worked 24/7 on this incident for 10 days.

### **YUCCA VALLEY COVERAGE**

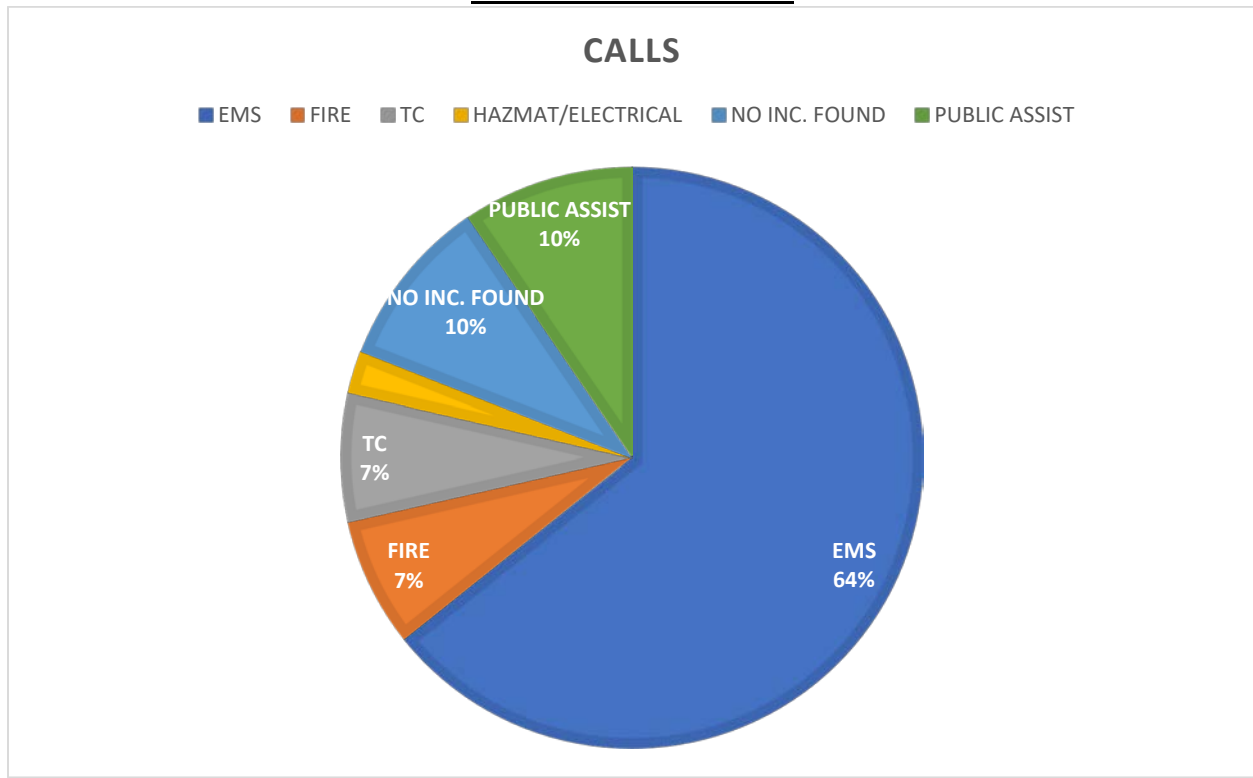
At the same time, BE461 was sent to cover the CALFIRE Station in Yucca Valley to cover the SRA (State Responsibility Area) in support of the State Mission. We have a very close relationship with CALFIRE and rely on them for mutual responses just as they rely on us to cover their areas during these types of emergencies. While on assignment for the State, BE461 responds to fires throughout the Morongo Basin with the potential to be dispatched anywhere in the state. In their 3 weeks at CALFIRE Station 14, BE461 responded to multiple fires in Joshua Tree, Twentynine Palms, Morongo Valley and Lucerne and Johnson Valley.

### **SDRMA CREDIT INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

Every year the Morongo Valley CSD and Fire Department participate in SDRMA's Credit Incentive Program. So far this year we have already saved \$1,362 in CIP Points for Property / Liability and \$831 in CIP Points for Workers Compensation. That is a total of \$2,193 as of the end of September. We will be implementing this program throughout the rest of the year to try and further our savings.
