LAKE FIRE / SCU LIGHTENING COMPLEX FIRE

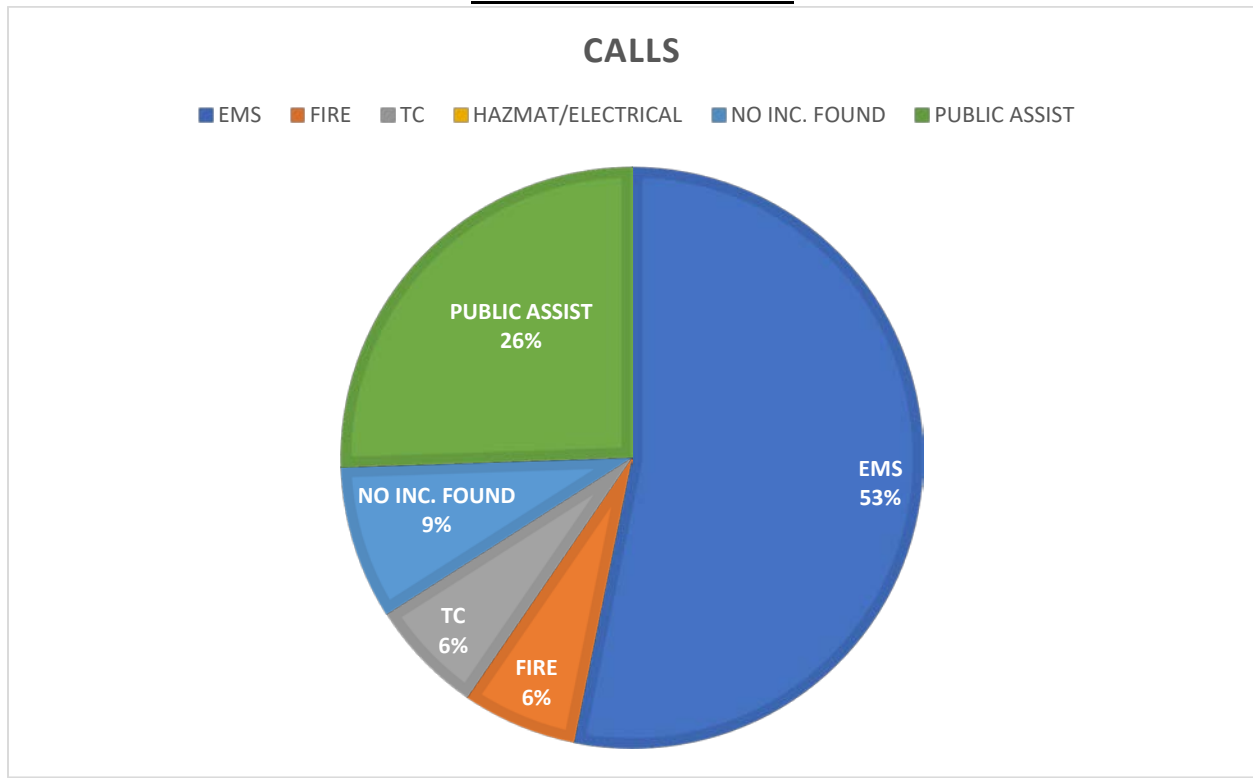
